The California Inland Empire Youth Band uses the Venturing model of the Boy Scouts of America. We are modeled after the Madison Scouts of DCI fame. Our primary venue is marching. Membership in the band through application to the BSA will facilitate the required insurance and access to uniform parts each member needs in the least expensive way. Registered scouts do not have to pay new fees.

Tryouts are conducted after your first rehearsal with the band. You need to have a command of your instrument and ability to bring it to rehearsal/meetings.

Our goal is to reach the Tournament of Roses Parade by offering fine musicianship and marching skills. We also want to perform at Disneyland and Knott's Berry farm. Long term goals include joining Drum Corps International and competing nationally.
