

Annawon Council - 2015 Cubmobile Derby

May 9, 2015 – Raynham Park

Event Guidelines and Procedures

Clothing Requirements:

1. Class B uniforms are preferred but all participants must wear long sleeve shirts under T-shirt and long pants. Shorts are not allowed.
2. All racers are required to wear helmets. Knee and elbow pads are recommended.
3. Closed toed shoes are required.

Cubmobile requirements:

1. Cubmobile length should not exceed 60" and width should not exceed 40".
2. Wheel diameter must not exceed 12".
3. Cubmobiles must be equipped with a seatbelt.
4. Cubmobiles must be equipped with a handbrake.
5. Cubmobiles must not have any loose parts or objects that could cause impalement.
6. All Cubmobiles will go through "Pit Road" inspection prior to being entered into the race.

Procedures:

1. All participants must first check in at the registration desk where numbers will be distributed.
2. Cubmobiles will be brought to the "Pit Road" inspection area for pre-race inspection. "Pit Road" can also be used for repairs prior to and during the race.
3. If more than one driver will be using an individual Cubmobile, notification should be made at time of registration.
4. Each driver will compete in 3 heats. 3 drivers will be racing and 3 drivers will be announced as on deck for the following heats. This will continue until all heats have been completed.
5. Drivers will be racing for time. Times for a driver's 3 heats will be averaged for a single score.
6. Race start will be a push start. Pushers will be allowed 3 steps before they must release the Cubmobile.
7. Time Keepers will be located at the finish line of each lane and will record the finish time for the driver. If a Cubmobile fails to cross the finish line, the heat for that driver will be considered finished and no time will be recorded for that heat.
8. Following a driver's heat, Cubmobiles should be returned to the finish line by the driver or Pack volunteer.
9. At no time shall a scout, parent, or bystander enter the race lanes unless permitted by an event volunteer.
10. A Pack time will be calculated based on the drivers' average times for that Pack.
11. The Pack with the lowest overall time will be awarded the Council Trophy for bragging rights throughout the year.
12. Drivers with the lowest average time for each rank will be awarded a trophy at the completion of the event.
13. Participation patches will be awarded to all drivers. Patches will not be available on the day of the event and will be sent to participating Packs for distribution.
