



2017 INTRODUCTION TO OUTDOOR LEADER SKILLS TRAINING GRAYBACK DISTRICT

TRAINING DATE: April 7-8, 2017

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This training reviews and trains adult leaders on outdoor skills found in the Scout handbook and demonstrates how leaders can teach those same skills to the Scouts in their Troop. All skills covered in this training are required for Scouts to earn rank advancements.

POSITIONS: For all Scout and Varsity Leaders
