- NYLT is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members with leadership skills and experiences they can use in their home troops, crews, personal lives, and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.
- The NYLT course simulates a month in the life of a troop over two weekends (Friday Night to Sunday Night).
- Dates of Course are Sat March 5th (All Day), 1st Weekend is March 18th to 20th and 2nd Weekend is April 1st to 3rd.
- Cost of Course will be \$125.00 This will cover Class B (T-Shirt), Supplies and Meals. Please note that participants will be required to bring food for their overnight outpost on the 2nd weekend.
- If signed up before Jan 1st 2016 Cost of Course will be \$115.00.
