Scouting Volunteers & Parents,

As you know from previous communication, the consolidation of the Annawon and Narragansett Councils was approved last week, and we are very excited to start the process of bringing the two Scouting families together. As part of the consolidation process it was agreed that all Staff would retain their positions with the newly combined Council. With that in mind, most of the staff will relocate to the East Providence Office beginning on September 23. The Norton Scout Shop will be closed for the day of September 23 while all staff attend an orientation meeting. The Norton Scout Shop will adjust its hours beginning on September 24th to Monday through Friday, Noon to 5:30PM, to accommodate those customers who wish to do Scouting business over the lunch hour or shortly after their work day.

As an added benefit and additional resource from this new partnership, please also note that there are now additional Scout Stores available to all Scout volunteers and parents. The Swansea, MA Scout Shop and Warwick, RI Scout Shop are both open Monday through Saturday 10AM to 8PM, and Sundays Noon to 6PM, as well as most holidays. You will be able to conduct all of your Scouting business at any of these three locations (registrations, advancements, reservations, etc.). In addition, customers may also call any of the three Scout Shops to place an order by phone, and those purchases can be arranged to be shipped for your added convenience.
