- Refurbish and relocate the flagpole on park property
- Replace the adobe walkway at the Hampton House and the Art Colony
- Replace the concrete walkway to the railroad building
- Grade the rear of Railroad clubhouse
- Grade the rear of the Art Colony building
- Install a perennial\drought tolerant garden to the rear of the Art Colony building with drip irrigation.
- Trim an existing Eagle project between the Art Colony and the Railroad building.
- Repaint the wrought iron fence around the lemon grove.
- Continue the existing walkway with decomposed granite surface and brick border.
- Install a free standing block retaining wall to allow the continuation of the brick\decomposed granite walkway.
- Continue the gazebo step as a "L" shaped retaining wall topped with tile steps at the Hampton House
- Repaint the gazebo with satin/semi-gloss paint. Repair\replace damaged woodwork as needed.
- Remove existing grass and plant boxwood hedging at the Hampton House facing Foothill Parkway. Install a drip irrigation system. **(This project is already under way and permits have already been pulled).**
- Refurbish an historical artifact (hay rake, tractor, etc.) located at the museum and construct a concrete slab; secure so it is theft resistant
