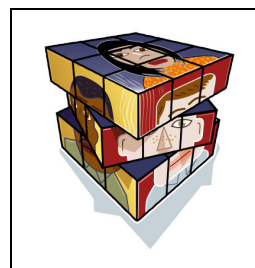


Camp SPECTACULAR

at Clover Patch Camp in Glenville, NY
Camp will be held August 13-17, 2007



A week long social day camp experience for children who have autism spectrum disorders including those with high functioning autism, Asperger syndrome and PDD-NOS

The Camp is for children who:

- are between the ages of 10 (by July 1) and 15
- have average or above average language skills
- have demonstrated self-management skills in school and community settings
- are interested in experiencing a wide variety of camp experiences including:
 - *swimming
 - *athletic activities
 - *team building
 - *arts and crafts
 - *music and drama
 - *outdoor activities

Program Details: The program will consist of two groups (age 10-12 and 13-15), each led by a certified special education teacher and supported by experienced counselors. A licensed social worker, who specializes in working with children on the spectrum, will be available and run a daily program for each group. Cost will be \$300 per camper.

Enrollment will be limited to 12 campers in each group. Applications will be reviewed based on youngster's appropriateness for the program and his or her need for a summer program. The deadline for applications is May 15, 2007. Applications must be complete in order for a child to be considered.
