



Announcing the 2010 California Inland Empire Council 100th Anniversary Patch Design Contest

The 100th Anniversary Committee for the California Inland Empire Council needs your help in designing a patch to represent the 100th Anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America here in the Inland Empire.

We will be looking for a patch that best exhibits creativity, originality, and visual appeal. The Theme will be "100th Anniversary in the CIEC". The winning design will be used to make a council patch to commemorate the 100th Anniversary Celebrations in CIEC and will also be used in every other patch design that is made in 2010 for CIEC. This is a lot of patches to be sure.

Here are the rules for the contest:

1. Entries must be submitted to the council offices on or before August 31st, 2009.
2. Contest open to registered YOUTH members of the California Inland Empire Council, BSA only. Youth will be considered under the age of 21 as of the contest deadline.
3. Design will include the words "BSA" or "Boy Scouts of America", "100th Anniversary in the [California Inland Empire Council]" or "[CIEC]", and the Fleur-de-lis.
4. All designs must be submitted full scale, 1:1, or 1" = 1"
5. Digital entries can be accepted via email address below, Attn: 100th Anniversary Patch Contest, and must be in .jpg or .pdf format. Entry must include submitters name, address, phone number, and unit information.
6. Hand drawn entries must be on an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper, must include the submitters name, address, phone number and unit information, and either dropped off at the council offices or mailed to: CIEC, Attn: 100th Anniversary Patch Contest, 1230 Indiana Ct., Redlands, Ca. 92374. Entry must arrive by August 31, 2009.
7. All designs become the property of the California Inland Empire Council, BSA. and may be altered to fit the patch manufacturing process and design criteria of the 100th Anniversary Committee of CIEC.

Just think of your design being on every patch this council makes in 2010. Camporee, Webelosree, Cub Day Camps, 2010 National Scout Jamboree, Council Shoulder Patch, Klondike, Camp Emerson and Helendade and many more.

The winner and the design will be announced at the September 17, 2009 Council Executive Board Meeting at 12:00 pm. Good luck to all who participate.
