Basic Information

Webelos Winter Blast will be a fun filled week of learning, excitement and fellowship. We hope your Scout(s) will attend and make this a time to remember in their Scouting careers.

- Packs may camp as a unit or Scouts may sign up by themselves. However every Scout must have an adult assigned prior to camp.
- All Scouts are expected to live by the Scout Oath and Law while at camp.
- All meals will be provided. First meal is lunch on Sunday, 12/20/09.
- All special dietary needs must be e-mailed no later than 12/1/09 to Camp Director.
- All Scouts and adults must bring a valid BSA class 1&2 or class 3 physical form with them to camp.
- Scouts/adults need to provide their own tent, sleeping bag, toiletries during camp.
- **NO HEATERS IN TENTS OF ANY KIND!**
- There will be a small trading post, it is recommended to bring \$20 to camp.

Webelos Activity Badges (Pin)

Citizen Activity Badge: Scouts will learn about what it takes to be a good citizen and the importance of our government and law enforcement agencies. This is a required activity badge for the Webelos Badge. Pre-requisite: Citizenship Belt Loop requirement #1 has to be completed prior to arriving to camp. Scouts will complete a Good Turn service project while at camp to complete this requirement.



Communicator Activity Badge: Scouts will have the opportunity to explore various ways to communicate with each other by learning about various jobs in communication, playing simple games, creating their own secret code and earning the computer belt loop by writing a letter of their experience at camp to bring home to you.



Engineer Activity Badge: Scouts will learn why floor plans are essential, how electricity is generated and be able to build a mini catapult upon completion of activity badge. Pre-requisite: Math Belt Loop requirement #2 has to be completed prior to arriving to camp.



Handyman Activity Badge: Scouts will learn simple car and bicycle maintenance and safety. Upon completion of activity badge they will have a mini bike rodeo. Pre-requisite: Responsibility, Character & Connection #c has to be completed prior to arriving to camp. Please bring a bicycle and helmet!



Check-In/Out

Check-in will be between 9am – 10am on Sunday, 12/20/09

Check-out will be between 10:30am – 11:30am on Wednesday, 12/23/09

Family night will be on Tuesday, 12/22/09. Feel free to come out and have dinner (\$5 fee) or to visit with your child however remember camp isn't over until Wednesday morning, please don't take him home...instead bring a tent and spend the night and leave Wednesday morning with your son after he has 100% completed camp. Please stop by the Ames Building to properly sign in and out.

Fees & Refunds

Leader cost: For every 8 Scouts from the Pack a leader (an adult responsible for Scouts) will be free otherwise the Leader fee is \$70 per adult. All leaders will receive a patch and sweatshirt. Swapping out leaders during the week is ok, however there is a charge (\$30) for the new adult sweatshirt and patch if they would like one, please fill out a registration form for each adult, and specify how they are going to swap out during the week.

Refund Policy: All refunds must be made via e-mail to Jerry.Scogin@Scouting.org. A 100% refund will be issued if the request is submitted by the close of business 1 November 2009. A 50% refund will be issued if the request is submitted by the close of business 15 November 2009. No refund requests will be accepted after close of business 21 November 2009. The only exceptions that will be entertained are death of an immediate family member or serious illness of Scout. (Doctor's note required) All refund requests must receive Camp Director approval. In the event a refund is approved after the 21 November 2009 date, a 75% deduction for food, supplies and recognition will be taken out of the total amount paid.

CPR and Wilderness First Aid classes at Winter Blast are only for adults. Youth will not have the time due to other program offerings. Wilderness First Aid will be offered December 28 and 29 for an additional \$60. There will be a CPR class December 30 that will cover adult, child and AED for \$10 in addition to all other fees. Class size is limited.

Each Scout or Scout Leader Must have a completed Webelos Winter Blast Application. One Winter Blast payment form may be used for multiple Scouts, leaders and programs.
