The Eagle Scout Award is the highest award a boy can earn in the Scouting program, and is given as much for the Scouts personal leadership and character qualifications as it is for his attainment of Scout skills. The Boy Scouts of America and Eagle Board of Review are very interested in your evaluation and comments in regard to my leadership ability and personal qualities. Please comment on these, using the attached form. Then place it in the enclosed envelope and mail it.
