

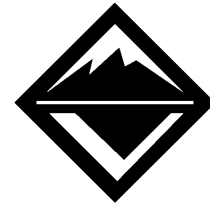
Wood Badge for the 21st Century

The West Central Florida Council is offering Wood Badge for the 21st Century to all registered Scouters in the council. Wood Badge is the ultimate leadership training program for adult Scout leaders. The course brings together leaders from all areas of Scouting – Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts & Venturing along with district and council leaders.

All course participants are required to have completed New Leader Essentials or This is Scouting along with Specific Basic Training for their registered Scouting position. Cub Scout leaders must complete Cub Leader Specific Training. Scoutmasters & Assistant Scoutmasters must complete Scoutmaster Specific Training along with Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills. Troop committee leaders must complete the Troop Committee Challenge. Varsity Scout leaders must complete Varsity Specific Training and Venturing leaders must complete Venturing Specific Training. District and council leaders must complete the training specific to their position. Leaders who have completed Cub Basics, Scoutmastership Fundamentals (SMF) or Venturing Training under the old training curriculum already meet the training requirements. In addition, an Annual Health and Medical Form # 34605 physical current for the course will be required.

The course will be conducted at Camp Soule over two 3-day weekends. The dates and times are Friday, February 26, 2010 at 7:30 AM to Sunday, February 28, 2010 at 5:00 PM and Friday, March 26, 2010 at 7:30 AM to Sunday, March 28, 2010 at 5 PM. The first weekend is held primarily in a classroom with overnight stay in campsites. The second weekend is an outdoor camping experience.

The course fee is \$175. This fee must be paid in full on or before January 15, 2010. Please complete the form below and return it to the Council Service Center along with your deposit of \$50 to reserve your spot for the course. There is only room for the first 48 applicants paid in full with training prerequisites and current physical.
