Arrival Information: Arrive at 11:00AM on Monday or Tuesday. Meet at Killgore Adventures in White Bird, ID. Killgore Adventures is located on the Salmon River one mile South of White Bird, Idaho. Take the White Bird exit off Hwy. 95. Turn left at the stop sign in town and travel 1 (one) mile. There are signs pointing to Hell's Canyon Jet Boat Trips and Lodging! **Note: The first meal provided is a sack lunch on the scheduled day of arrival.**

<p>Participant Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America. • Must be at least 13 years of age on January 1, 2010. • Must pass the standard BSA swim test, and be classified as a "swimmer", prior to arrival at camp. • Must be in good physical condition. • Must provide a completed BSA Annual Health and Medical Record, signed by a physician no more than 12 months prior to the trip. • Must sign the "High Adventure Hold Harmless / Release Agreement". Participants under the age of 18 must have this form signed by a parent / legal guardian. 	<p>Unit Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must provide proof of unit insurance. • Must submit a unit roster with final payment. • Must submit the "Swim Test Verification Form" at least two weeks prior to the trip. • Units are responsible for transportation to and from Killgore Adventures in White Bird, ID. • Must train all adult leaders in Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat prior to arrival. • Review the "Participant and Leaders Guide" prior to arrival. • Must submit the Killgore Adventures Liability Release form, complete with parent signatures

FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Please include Unit number, point of contact, and updated number of participants with every payment.

To secure a high adventure reservation, submit this completed reservation form and a **\$50 per person non-refundable deposit** (this will be applied to camp fees). Your reservation will be held until January 8, 2010. Reservations are subject to cancellation until payment is received.

- **January 8, 2010**
Second deposit in the amount of **\$250 per person is due.**
- **March 19, 2010**
All remaining fees are due and all fees received become non-refundable.
- Fees are transferable to another Scout from your unit to attend the same session, as long as the total number of Scouts scheduled to attend during that session remains the same.

All fees must be paid in full by March 19th or units risk losing their reservation without a refund.

Two-Deep Leadership

The Boy Scouts of America policy, (refer to the *Guide to Safe Scouting*) requires that two registered adult leaders, or one registered adult and a parent of a participating Scout, one of whom must be at least 21 years of age or older, are required to attend unit outings.

Your unit may have youth that wish to participate in the rafting trip without adults that are able to attend. In such cases, with prior arrangements made with the Inland Northwest Council, the North Idaho High Adventure staff can serve as the adult leadership for your youth. Please be aware of the following parameters:

1. Requests for North Idaho High Adventure staff to serve as the leaders for your youth must be submitted in writing no later than the March 19th payment.
2. The unit leadership and/or parents are responsible to provide transportation for youth to and from Killgore Adventures in White Bird, ID at the start and conclusion of the trip.
3. Youth attending the rafting trip without unit leadership must have a *Parent Release/Hold Harmless* agreement signed by a parent or legal guardian. For a copy of the form contact the Spokane Service Center at 1-800-945-4390.

REFUND POLICY:

All but \$50 of the fee is refundable through March 19th. No fees will be refunded after March 19, 2010, unless there is an illness or injury documented by a medical doctor, a death in the family or relocation of the family out of the area. Since camp has already incurred expenses related to guides, bus contracts, equipment rental and food, \$250 of the fee IS NOT REFUNDABLE REGARDLESS OF CIRCUMSTANCES after March 19th. The unit leader or camp coordinator must request all refunds in writing and submit to the Inland Northwest Council on or before the planned date of arrival in camp (letters may be submitted at check-in at camp.) NO REFUND REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED IF RECEIVED AFTER CHECK-IN. Fees are transferable to other Scouts as long as the total number of scheduled Scouts does not decrease.
