2008 Pacifica District Cub Scout Day Camp Program Overview

Welcome! The NASCAR Day Camp starts each day with an 8:00 to 8:40 am arrival and check-in and the day begins with opening ceremonies at 8:40 am (7:30 to 8:40 registration on Monday). Activities will include boating, swimming, archery, crafts, nature, songs, games, feats of skills, and BB Guns (WEBELOS only). Closing ceremonies end at 4 pm, Friday at 3:30 pm.

The NASCAR Racers, their parent/guardian and one guest are invited to participate Thursday night at the Campfire. An adult is required for each scout to participate in the Campfire which starts at 5 pm and should end before 9 pm.

Due to space and safety, participation in the evening is limited to the Cub Scout camper, an adult partner, and one guest.

WEBELOS WEEKEND

WEBELOS and their adult partners are welcome to participate in Friday night through Sunday morning. Campout sponsored by Cabrillo Beach Youth Waterfront Sports Center

(CBYWSC).

Please note:

Due to insurance restrictions, younger siblings or friends may not enter the campgrounds except during drop-off or pickup. *Only registered Scouts (Campers and Den Chiefs) and adult volunteers are allowed on the campgrounds during the week.*

Deadlines

Please fill out the online Application. Deadline for reservations is midnight June 13th. Reservations, per week, are limited to the first 180 Cubs. Registration fee is \$125 (plus \$10 processing fee). No refund requests will be granted after June 13th.

Discount of \$25 is available if registered by April 30th, 2008.



Summary of Rules

(See pages 3-5 for more details)

1. Camp T-shirts and shorts or jeans must be worn each day. Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times (thongs or sandals are not allowed). An extra pair of shoes (old sneakers / beach shoes / wet socks) **ARE REQUIRED** for launching boats. Each boy must bring a water bottle, towel, hat, sun block, and a wind breaker.
2. Medicines must be given to the camp medic with original prescription bottle and instruction. Please ask your pharmacist to prepare a "camp dosage".
3. Any boy whose discipline is disruptive will be sent home and not allowed back, without refund. Parents must agree to pick up the child immediately if called for discipline problems. No video games, radios, tape players, etc will be allowed.
4. Each boy is responsible for his own transportation. Check with unit leaders for car-pooling. Please plan to pick up boys promptly each day. Be sure sign him in and out with their den leaders. Permission slips are required for all boys in car pools. Packs must file tour permits.
5. Each Pack must supply the minimum number of adult volunteers before their cub scouts can be registered.
 - Tiger Cub: ***Each Tiger Cub must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian***
 - 1 to 5 cub scouts: 1 Full Time (present all 5 days) adult
 - 6 to 9 cub scouts: 1 Full Time (present all 5 days) adult **AND** 2 part time adults per day
 - 10 to 15 cub scouts: 2 Full Time adults (present all 5 days) **AND** 2 part time adults per day
 - 16 to 20 cub scouts: 2 Full Time adults (present all 5 days) **AND** 4 part time adults per day
6. A mandatory training session (attend only one) for all adult volunteers and den chiefs will be held 3:00 pm Saturday June 28th **and** 6:00 pm Tuesday July 1st, 2008 at LDS Church, 501 Rowell Ave., Manhattan Beach.
7. Adult swim checks are available at CBYWSC on Friday nights between 4 and 7 pm or Saturday mornings between 8 and 9 am, starting in June. Boys will be tested the first day of camp.
8. Boys may bring a sack lunch and drink each day. For safety reasons, no glass containers or mayonnaise in the sack lunches.
9. Boys are not permitted to bring knives or matches to day camp. If an activity requires knives or matches, the day camp will provide them.
10. Swim Check test results on first day of camp are final. However, retest will be allowed on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings. If retested, test results are final.
11. Each den is expected to setup their camp area (tent, overhang shelter). Camp area assignments will be handed out at the training sessions. Setup may be done on Sunday July 13th and Sunday July 20th, after 2:00 pm. For those dens that can not attend the Sunday session, the camp will open at 7:15 am on Monday of both camp weeks to allow setup.
12. Den leaders are responsible for providing snacks and drinks. The camp has drinking fountains, soda machines and will offer Otter Pops for the afternoon break.
13. Please download from the registration site, fill out, sign, and hold for the Cub Scout/WEBELOS Den Leader to collect, forms A, B, C and D
14. Adult volunteers fill out forms D, E and H. (Cub Scout/WEBELOS Den Leader will collect these)
15. Den Chiefs fill out forms D, F, G and H. (Day Camp Den Chief Coordinator will collect these)

Camper Registration Instructions

All scouts wishing to attend camp must register online for their week.

The following forms must be downloaded, filled out, signed and held for collection by the Den Leader your son will be assigned to.

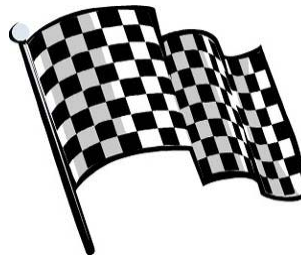


What to Wear and Bring

Camp T-shirts and shorts or jeans must be worn each day. Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times (thongs or sandals are not allowed). An extra pair of shoes (old sneakers / beach shoes / wet socks) **ARE REQUIRED** for launching boats. Each boy must bring a water bottle, towel, hat, sun block, and a wind breaker. A daypack is suggested. Please

mark all items with boy's name. **The camp is not responsible for lost items.**



Medicines

Medicines must be given to the camp medic with original prescription bottle and instruction. Please ask your pharmacist to prepare a "camp dosage".



Discipline

Any boy whose discipline is disruptive will be sent home and not allowed back, **without refund**. Parents must agree to pick up the child immediately if called for discipline problems. **No video games, radios, tape players, etc will be allowed. Knives are not allowed; if an activity requires a knife, it will be provided by the Day Camp.**

Lunches

Five day lunch meal tickets may be purchased prior to camp. Just indicate on application and include fee with registration payment. Note, meal tickets must be purchased for all 5 days. Boys may bring a sack lunch and drink each day. For safety reasons, no glass containers or mayonnaise in the sack lunches.

Transportation

Each boy is responsible for his own transportation. Check with unit leaders for car-pooling. Please plan to pick up boys promptly each day. Be sure sign him in and out with their den leaders. Permission slips are required for all boys in car pools. **Packs must file tour permits.**

Adult Volunteer Registration Information

ADULT VOLUNTEERS

Each Pack must supply the minimum number of adult volunteers before their cub scouts can be registered.

All adult volunteers wishing to attend camp must fill out the appropriate application consisting of:

- Completed **On Line Registration of Adult Volunteer**
- **FORM E:** Cabrillo Summer Day Camp Medical Information Sheet (Adult)
- **FORM H:** Day Camp Adult Volunteer / Den Chief Agreement
- A confirmation letter will be sent after your online registration is complete

REQUIRED ADULT VOLUNTERS PER PACK

- Tiger Cub: *Each Tiger Cub must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian*
- 1 to 5 cub scouts: 1 Full Time (present all 5 days) adult
- 6 to 9 cub scouts: 1 Full Time (present all 5 days) adult AND 2 part time adults per day
- 10 to 15 cub scouts: 2 Full Time adults (present all 5 days) AND 2 part time adults per day
- 16 to 20 cub scouts: 2 Full Time adults (present all 5 days) AND 4 part time adults per day

“Part Time Adult Volunteer” means that it can be a different adult per day.

- **FORM H:** Day Camp Adult Volunteer / Den Chief Agreement

Webelos Weekend Instructions

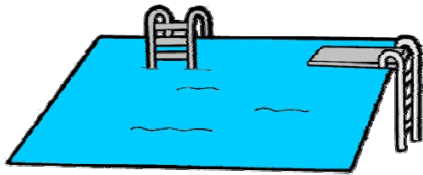

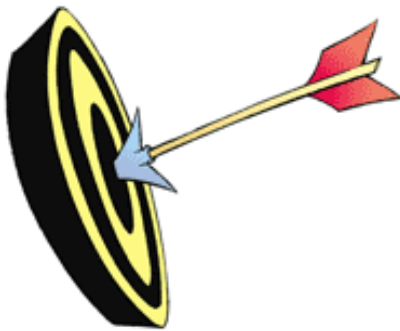


Mandatory Training: Adult Volunteers and Den Chiefs

A mandatory training session (attend only one) for all adult volunteers and den chiefs will be held 3:00 pm Saturday June 28th and 6:00 pm Tuesday July 1st, 2008 at LDS Church, 501 Rowell Ave., Manhattan Beach.

Swim checks will be offered on Friday nights between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. or Saturday mornings between 8 a.m. and 9 am, starting in June at Cabrillo Beach Youth Waterfront Sports Center, in Cabrillo Beach, San Pedro. Swim checks are necessary for all volunteers and den chiefs participating in swimming and boating activities. Adults only; no campers will be allowed to perform swim checks at these times.

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Tips for the Pack

Following are tips for packs to make the registration process easier.

- Make sure that your pack can provide the required adult volunteers.
- Designate one person to coordinate all the day camp applications from the pack.
- Register prior to the cut-off date to get “Early Bird” discount.
- Establish car pools.
- Boys will be given a swim test on Monday. Please advise parents to make sure that their children are ready (medication, goggles, etc.). Swim test results are final, but boys may retake the swim test on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday mornings. If retested, test results are final.
