Additional Information

Webelos Rank

This year will be different from any other Weboree year. The Webelos will be grouped as either 1st or 2nd year Webelos.

LDS units if your Webelos scouts birthday is between 5-1-14 thru 10-31-14 list them as 1st year Webelos. If their birthday is between 10-1-13 and 4-30-14 list them as 2nd year Webelos. Each group will be attending different sessions to help in their progress from either Cub Scout or soon into Boy Scouts. On the shirt form please indicate which group they go into.

Miscellaneous

- All youth, adults, and visitors must adhere to the Guide to Safe Scouting including but not limited to drinking, smoking, appropriate attire, and closed in shoes.
